The Cultural Alliance of Greater Washington (CAGW), in keeping with its mission, has undertaken *The Arts Show and Tell*, a project designed to provide member organizations with an opportunity to inform the public about their work through the creation of television programming. Each 12-minute segment about an arts organization is designed for broadcast on community television and subsequent promotional use by the organization and CAGW. (**Name of Arts Organization**) The Organization has applied and been selected to be featured in a television segment (the Segment). The Segment will be combined with a segment about another arts organization and with material promoting the work of CAGW and TICKETPLACE to form a television program (the Program) that will be broadcast on Arlington Independent Media and/or through other outlets. Double R Productions (the Producer) has agreed to produce the Segment pursuant to an agreement between the Producer and CAGW. The terms and conditions applicable to the production and use of the Segment are set forth below.

1. Coordination with Producer. Arts Organization agrees to consult and work closely with the Producer and with Arlington Independent Media by facilitating logistics, arranging interviews, and performing such other tasks as are reasonably requested by the Producer.

2. Ownership and Copyright. Arts Organization understands that CAGW will own all rights, including copyrights, trademarks and servicemarks to the Segment and the Program and that CAGW will accordingly have the right to exploit the Segment and the Program in perpetuity throughout the world in any media (whether existing, known or hereafter created) for any purpose of CAGW.

3. Representations and Warranties; License to CAGW. It will be Arts Organization's responsibility to obtain releases in the form attached as Exhibit A from all persons whose appearances or voices will be recorded in connection with production of the Segment and to submit a complete set of releases to CAGW prior to commencement of filming. Arts Organization represents and warrants that it either owns or has obtained permission, if any is necessary, to license, and hereby does license, CAGW to record and use any musical, literary, photographic, motion picture, artistic, graphic, choreographic or other work that will be recorded in connection with the Segment and shall provide written evidence satisfactory to counsel for CAGW to such effect.

4. Indemnification. Arts Organization agrees to indemnify and hold harmless CAGW and its officers, directors, employees, subcontractors and agents from and against damages, losses or expenses (including, without limitation, reasonable attorneys fees) resulting from any breach of its warranties hereunder and/or from any claim arising out of the creation or use of the
